**January 17, 2019** – The District of Thunder Bay Social Services Administration Board (TBDSSAB) is seeking interested candidates to apply to the Community Homelessness Prevention Initiative (CHPI) Advisory Table.

As a service system manager, TBDSSAB may use CHPI funding to address local priorities and better meet the needs of individuals and families who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless. CHPI provides flexibility to use the funding for any of the four broad service categories:

- Emergency Shelter Solutions
- Housing with Related Supports
- Other Services and Supports
- Homelessness Prevention

The purpose of the TBDSSAB CHPI Advisory Table is to review current CHPI programs and funding agreements and to identify new opportunities for consideration to assist TBDSSAB in meeting its strategic priorities to broaden engagement and participation of our rural and urban stakeholders.
